A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE  
2002 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (RTIP) TO INCLUDE  
THE JOB ACCESS AND REVERSE COMMUTE- FUNDED WAYS TO WORK PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission has adopted the *2002 Regional Transportation Improvement Program* consistent with the Santa Cruz County *Regional Transportation Plan*, state law (including SB 45) and the California Transportation Commission STIP Guidelines;

WHEREAS Congress has earmarked Federal Transit Administration Job Access and Reverse Commute funds to the Ways to Work, California program on behalf of the Family Service Agency of the Central Coast to provide loans to help low-income wage earners overcome transportation barriers to commute to work;

WHEREAS projects granted federal transportation funds must be listed in the Federal/Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP) administered by the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments; and

WHEREAS, The Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission has established a process whereby the Commission amends projects into the *Regional Transportation Improvement Program* (RTIP), then requests that they be amended into the MTIP.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION:

1. The *2002 Regional Transportation Improvement Program* is hereby amended, as shown on Exhibit A, to include the Ways to Work project.
2. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments is hereby requested to amend the MTIP consistent with the above RTIP amendment.
