Re: Article 8 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Allocation Request for \$41,005 for Glen Canyon Road Sidewalks in the City of Scotts Valley

RECOMMENDATION

The Elderly & Disabled Transportation Advisory Committee and staff recommend that the Regional Transportation Commission:

Approve by resolution (Attachment 1) the City of Scotts Valley's FY 2003/04 Article 8 Transportation Development Act Allocation Claim for the construction of sidewalks on the east side of Glen Canyon Road.

BACKGROUND

Each year the Regional Transportation Commission allocates Article 8 Transportation Development Account (TDA) funds to local jurisdictions for bikeway and pedestrian projects. TDA funds allocated to a local jurisdiction may be rolled over from one fiscal year to the next. Claims with pedestrian amenities must be reviewed by the Elderly & Disabled Transportation Advisory Committee prior to approval by the Regional Transportation Commission.

DISCUSSION

The City of Scotts Valley is requesting \$41,005 in TDA funds to construct a sidewalk and pedestrian railing on the east side of Glen Canyon Road from the intersection of Oak Creek Boulevard to Flora Lane (Attachment 1, Exhibit A). Glen Canyon Road is part of the Federal Highway Administration System and is designated as a major collector street. The City of Scotts Valley has an adequate balance of TDA funds for this claim. The Elderly & Disabled Transportation Advisory Committee reviewed the claim at their June 8 meeting and unanimously recommended approval.

SUMMARY

The City of Scotts Valley has requested an allocation of TDA funds for the sidewalk construction on Glen Canyon Road. The Elderly & Disabled Transportation Advisory Committee and staff recommend that the Regional Transportation Commission approve the allocation for the attached \$41,005 claim.
