A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING \$41,005 IN AVAILABLE ARTICLE 8  
TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA) FUNDS FOR THE CITY OF SCOTTS  
VALLEY FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON GLEN CANYON ROAD

WHEREAS the City of Scotts Valley has \$41,005 in unallocated  
Article 8 TDA revenues accumulated from FY 2003/04 and earlier  
fiscal years; and

WHEREAS the Article 8 TDA claims have been reviewed and are  
recommended for approval by the Elderly & Disabled Transportation  
Advisory Committee;

WHEREAS Glen Canyon Road is part of the Federal Highway  
Administration System and is designated as a major collector  
street;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION  
COMMISSION:

1. \$41,005 in FY 2003/2004 Article 8 TDA funds is hereby  
allocated to the City of Scotts Valley for construction  
of a sidewalk and pedestrian railing on the east side  
of Glen Canyon Road from the intersection of Oak Creek  
Boulevard to Flora Lane as shown in Exhibit A.
