



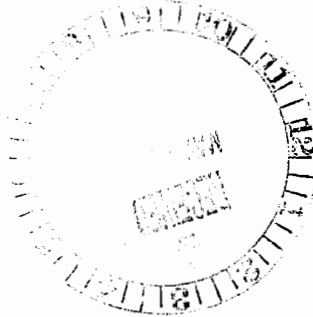

At its April 26, 2005, meeting, the City Council adopted Resolution Nos. NS-26,858 and NS-26,857, authorizing the City to act as claimant for the fiscal year 2006 Transportation Development Act funds, allocated by the Commission for the Volunteer Center and for the Lift Line Program, which includes the subsidized taxi program through Community Bridges, Inc./Consolidated Transportation Services Agency.
