**Subject:** Railroad corridor digital drawings

Hi Luis,

Here is a summary of the scope of the work that includes the additional items that you requested.

Compile and furnish electronic data files of maps of the railroad corridor currently under consideration for purchase by the SCCRTC in portable document format (\*.PDF). Furnish a brief summary document stating the methodology and description of the maps we create. This set of maps will be based on the AutoCAD drawings furnished to us by the Santa Cruz County Assessor. This set of drawings is intended to be used for graphical presentation and will be drawn with a level of accuracy conducive to this purpose. These drawings will not represent a precise boundary map of the parcels so depicted. If in the future the SCCRTC should require a greater level of precision, these drawings would need to be further refined as may be required.

The maps will consist of:

1. 1 overview map of the entire corridor w/ the corridor broken up into 6 segment maps. This overview map will have minimal detail, and will primarily be used as a guide to locate the 6 segment maps.
2. 6 segment maps will have major street names and various streams and rivers called out. Cities names will be added to the maps. Wilder and New Brighton Park will be added. Each of the six segments will be broken up into small maps. The segment maps will have minimal detail, and be used as a guide to locate the small maps in each segment.
3. The 68 small maps will be to scale (1:200). They will have the dimensions that you have previously observed. No additional information will be added to the maps (except as listed below). Parcel boundaries will be shown (no parcel numbers), streams, rivers, lakes will be shown (names may not be present), streets will be shown (names may not be present).

The following information will be on each map

1. Sheet numbers
2. The files will be in color.
3. North arrow
4. A legend with major items designated: streets, streams, rail corridor. Items will be designated by color. Colors of items are related to color of lines used in original AutoCAD drawings from the Assessors Office and will not be changed.

Our lump sum price for this will be **\$7500** + Reimbursable expenses. Reimbursable expenses are listed on the billing rate schedule that we sent you with are last proposal.

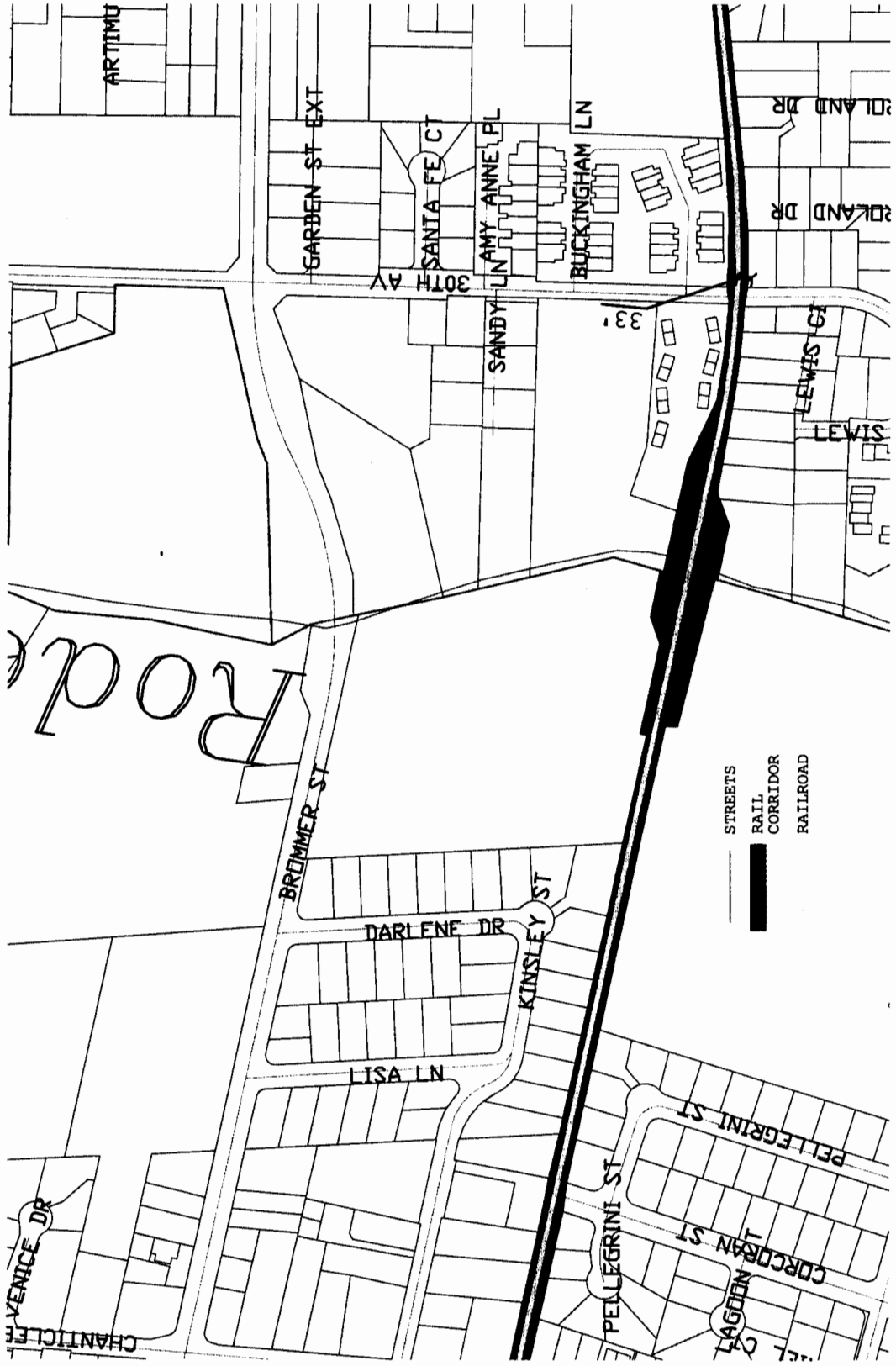
If you accept this description of work and price, I will put together a proposal. Please let me know if there is any additional information that you require.
