A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO EXPEND \$50,000 PER YEAR IN SAFE FUNDS BETWEEN JANUARY 1, 2006 AND DECEMBER 31ST, 2008 TO PROVIDE EXTRA CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL (CHP) ENFORCEMENT ON HIGHWAY 17 AND TO AMEND OR ENTER INTO THE NECESSARY AGREEMENTS WITH THE METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (MTC) SAFE AND THE CHP TO ENSURE CONTINUATION OF THE SAFE ON 17 PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in 2002 SCCRTC SAFE entered into a 3-year cooperative funding agreement with MTC SAFE and into a contract agreement with CHP to provide extra CHP enforcement services on Highway 17;

WHEREAS, the of cooperative funding agreement with MTC and the CHP contract agreement for extra enforcement on Highway 17 will expire on December 31ST, 2005;

WHEREAS, the extra CHP enforcement of the "Safe on 17" project has been very successful in reducing collisions on Highway 17; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the SCCRTC SAFE account to provide the level of funding to continue the "Safe on 17" project;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION:

The Executive Director is hereby authorized to expend \$50,000 per year in SAFE funds between January 1, 2006 and December 31ST, 2008 to provide extra CHP enforcement on Highway 17 and to amend and/or execute the necessary agreements with MTC SAFE and the CHP to ensure continued implementation the Safe on 17 Program.
