A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE
2006 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
TO SHIFT TEA, CMAQ, AND RSTP FUNDS
AMONGST CITY OF SANTA CRUZ PROJECTS AND
REALLOCATING \$67,914 IN ARTICLE 8 TDA FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission has prepared a *2006 Regional Transportation Improvement Program* (RTIP) consistent with the *2005 Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Plan* (RTP), state law (including SB 45) and the amended California Transportation Commission (CTC) *State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) Guidelines*, and in consultation and cooperation with the local project sponsors, the Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments (AMBAG) and Caltrans District 5;

WHEREAS, the Commission is responsible for programming Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ), Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), Transportation Enhancement Activity (TEA) and Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds and making amendments to the RTIP, as needed;

WHEREAS, the Commission previously programmed \$298,000 in Regional Transportation Enhancement Activity (TEA), \$380,000 in Regional Surface Transportation Program (RSTP), and over \$67,914 in Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds to the West Cliff Drive Bicycle/Pedestrian Path project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Cruz has requested to shift those previously programmed funds to other projects that will be ready for construction sooner than the West Cliff Drive project;

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Cruz's request acts as a TDA claim for unspent Article 8 funds; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION:

1. The *2006 Regional Transportation Improvement Program for Santa Cruz County* is hereby amended to:
 - a. Deprogram \$298,000 in TEA funds and \$380,000 in RSTP from the West Cliff Drive Bicycle/Pedestrian Path project;

- b. Trade \$298,000 in TEA funds for CMAQ funds from the Beach Street Bicycle Path Project;
- c. Reprogram \$298,000 in CMAQ funds and \$80,000 in RSTP funds, to the San Lorenzo River Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge project; and
- d. Reallocate \$67,914 in Article 8 TDA funds previously allocated to the West Cliff Drive project to the San Lorenzo River Bicycle/Pedestrian Bridge project; and
- e. Reprogram \$300,000 in RSTP funds to the Soquel Avenue Bicycle Lane project.

2. The Association of Monterey Bay Area Governments is hereby requested to incorporate these amendments into the *Metropolitan Transportation Improvement Program (MTIP)*.
