SUBJECT: 2006/2007 TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT
ARTICLE 8 PROJECT ALLOCATION CLAIM

Dear Mr. Dondero:

The County of Santa Cruz Department of Public Works requests an allocation of \$187,382 for the fiscal year 2006/2007 Transportation Development Act (TDA) funding for the two projects listed below.

- Calabasas Road School Pedestrian/Bike Safety Project\$100,000

This is a new project TDA allocation request using FY 2006/2007 TDA allocation funds for the design and construction of pedestrian and bicycle improvements on Calabasas Road and fronting the Calabasas Elementary School. The TDA request augments almost \$1,200,000 in Regional Surface Transportation Program funds, developer fees, and road funds. The project will provide for the construction of sidewalks and bike lanes from Buena Vista Drive to the school frontage. The project is consistent with the 2005 Regional Transportation Program, pages 68 through 73, policies 2.1, 2.4, 2.7, 3.1, 3.7, 4.1, 4.2, and 5.4.

- State Park Drive Improvements.....\$87,382

This TDA allocation request using FY 2006/07 TDA allocation funds supplements the previously allocated \$100,000 of TDA funds for pedestrian and bike lane improvements on State Park Drive as part of the Seacliff Village improvement project. The County has hired Bowman & Williams Civil Engineers to design the improvements within the Seacliff Village core area and on State Park Drive from Searidge Drive to Santa Cruz Avenue. This project is being developed through an extensive community process and in cooperation with State Parks. The project is consistent with the 2005 RTP, pages 68 through 73, policies 2.1, 2.4, 2.7, 2.8, 3.1, 3.3, 3.7, 4.1, 4.3, and 5.4.


