REGARDING: Regional Coordinated Traffic Counts Program-Agreement with Transportation Agency for Monterey County

RECOMMENDATIONS

Staff recommends that the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC) adopt the revised resolution ([Attachment 1](#)) approving an agreement between the Transportation Agency for Monterey County and the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission for Regional Coordinated Traffic Counts Program.

BACKGROUND

At its January 11, 2007 meeting, the RTC adopted a resolution authorizing the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with the Transportation Agency for Monterey County (TAMC) for coordinated traffic counts. There was a typographical error in the resolution and a revised resolution is attached.

DISCUSSION

The January 11, 2007 staff report and the draft agreement attached to the staff report stated that the RTC traffic counts contract would be increased by \$40,000 to accommodate the traffic counts required by TAMC. The resolution stated an increase of \$30,000. The revised resolution ([Attachment 1](#)) corrects that typographical error in the resolution to \$40,000 and adds language to allow for a greater increase, if it is needed for the counts requested by TAMC. The correction is in underline and strikethrough format. As stated in the resolution and the contract approved in January 2007, TAMC will reimburse the RTC for all counts done within Monterey County.

SUMMARY

The RTC approved a resolution for an agreement with TAMC for coordinated traffic counts. There was a typographical error in the resolution and a revised resolution ([Attachment 1](#)) is attached for approval.
