

Key updates are summarized below and included as Exhibit A to Attachment 1:

Executive Summary (Section I, p. 1)

- A new summary has been added to align with the Equity Plan and provide clearer context for the document.

General Rules and Regulations (Section III)

- Time and Place of Meeting (C- 2 & 3, p. 3): The Commission may hold a second meeting on the third Thursday of each month, as needed, at the discretion of the Chair. Updated to reflect current Brown Act requirements.
- Members' Reimbursement for Expense (D, p. 4): Updated reimbursement rates to provide \$100 per meeting for Commission meeting attendance and \$100 per month for attendance at one or more Commission committee meetings, not to exceed \$200 per month per member.
- Agenda (G-3, p. 5): The Executive Director shall provide each Commissioner and alternate with a current copy of the Ralph M. Brown Act upon appointment.
- Presiding at Meeting (I, p. 6): Clarifies the Chair's authority to limit participation of individuals engaging in disruptive behavior; includes provisions for disruptions caused by technology.
- Reading of Minutes (K, p. 6): Updated for SB 707 compliance.
- Abstaining from Voting (N, p. 7): Reaffirms that commissioners are ~~expected~~ **required** to vote on all matters unless they have a disqualifying conflict of interest.
- Public Comment (S, p. 8): The Commission Chair may set time limits for public comments on agenda items.
- Brown Act Compliance (U, p. 8): Adds reference to the new Disruption and Outage Policy (Exhibit 10).

Environmental Review Guidelines (Section XI B-3, p. 30)

- Updated to incorporate CEQA and NEPA compliance language.

Exhibit 2 – Bylaws for Commission Committees (p. 36)

- Voting procedures updated to require participation by all members present unless disqualified.

Exhibit 8-A – Conflict of Interest (p. 52)

- Updated to include designated positions requiring disclosure.
